- 6. <u>Licensing Application Gem Festival</u>.
 - a. Sam Southan of Pull Up Recordings described the festival, after which he answered many questions from the public and from Cllrs.
 - He agreed to add an additional road-sign to the Traffic Management Plan a 'No Access to the Festival' (or words to that effect) at the Five Lanes cross roads, to warn Festival traffic off driving down Tetbury Lane.
 - b. This was followed by the PC considering its view, at which point Lord Suffolk left the Hall. One Cllr said, while not specifically against this festival, that there were too many such events happening in Charlton Park. A poll was taken of residents' views, showing a strong majority supporting this event. Cllrs then voted, also with a strong majority not to object to the licensing application.
